Levels of corporate membership

There are three levels of corporate membership, depending on the level of contribution:

- **National Corporate member**
Membership fee: 1000 Euro per year.
- **Baltic Corporate member**
Membership fee: 3000 Euro per year.
- **Development Corporate member**
Membership fee: 5000 Euro per year.

All prospective corporate members must accept the Statutes of the association and be approved by the Board of the BICG.
